

riesling trentino DOC

description:

Of German/Austrian origin, the Riesling varietal has been grown for decades in the sunny vineyards of the Valle di Cembra in Trentino. This wine is made from grapes grown on 15–20-year-old vines that are trained on the Guyot system. It spends 2–3 months in bottle before release.
