The Sauvignon grapes are hand-picked for this classic wine from parcels in the Northeastern area of the Andriano vineyards. This area is known for producing Sauvignon Blanc with wonderful acidity and fresh aromas because of the cooler climate and longer growing season. The grapes are vinified in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature. The wines are allowed to mature on the fine lees for 6 months before bottling.
