The Lagrein varietal dates back to the 17th century in this region, thus it is recognized as one of the oldest in the Sud Tyrol region. Lagrein is noted for the deep red color it gives the wine and its unique fruity/spicy flavor profile. The grapes are hand-picked and fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks that also ensure the gentle must movement of the wine. For malolactic fermentation the wine is transferred to large oak casks where the wine rests till bottled in late September.
