Nebbiolo is the grape from which Barolo is made. It is important for the Scavino family to make a great Nebbiolo in every vintage from a selection of grapes. The Nebbiolo grapes come from declassified Barolo vineyards every vintage. This wine is a tribute to the varietal that made this land famous. The brief maceration and alcoholic fermentation are in temperature controlled steel tanks. The malolactic fermentation occurs in oak barrels and then the wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barriques before being blended in steel tanks and finally bottling.
