description:

The vineyard that produces the Schiava and Lagrein fruit for this indigenous blend joined the Terlano cooperative in 1963. Here, the predominately reddish mineral rich soil climbs 1300–2100 feet A.S.L. in the Dolomites near Bolzano. The temperature-controlled fermentation is carried out in stainless steel followed by gentle batonnage. Malolactic fermentation and aging in large casks follows.

This wine is ruby-red in color with violet reflexes. It has a multi-leveled bouquet, with nuances of violets underlined with gentle almond and walnut aromas. It is dry, medium-bodied, with a light trace of tannin and flavors of cherries.



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
