

# torilan vigneto delle dolomiti IGT

## description:

Winemaker Rudi Kofler has chosen the name Torilan for the first red cuvée ever produced from the Cantina Terlano. Torilan was the primeval name given to the South Tyrolean region we know today as Terlano. It is Kofler's belief that, "a cuvée is more than the sum of the varieties of grapes. It is a product of the art of composition, blending individual aromas to create a harmonious whole." Because Terlano offers such a dynamic range of diverse microclimates, it seemed logical to him that Torilan should be a blend that celebrates all the merits and complexities of their terroir.

Combining power and finesse, Torilan is a cohesive full-bodied wine that exhibits lush black fruits, tobacco and wild berry layers in a nicely supported mesh of velvety tannins.
