description:

These vineyards are in the commune of Capriva but are on the mountainside near the town. There are 4 acres, of which half are older vines and half newer vines. The newer vines are planted as small bush guyot and the older vineyard is the traditional cappuccina. Grape selection is done in the vineyard with frequent passages thus harvesting when the grapes are perfectly ripened.

An intense red color with bright reflections. A bountiful blackberry and raspberry bouquet with a distinct toastiness on the palate. Warm, medium-bodied with a persistent finish, this wine is nicely balanced. Excellent with hard aged cheeses, red meat, soups and hearty dishes.



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
